



<b>Position</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Auto Body Welders</b>	Weld components in flat, vertical or overhead positions. Position align and secure parts and assemblies.
<b>Body Techs</b>	Apply body filler and mud to vehicles - sand and prep removing/repairing waves and pin holes.
<b>Spray Painters</b>	Apply color and clear coats using SATA Paint System.
<b>Automotive Buffer</b>	Sand painted finish to remove imperfections.
<b>Assemblers</b>	Assemble and install vehicle carpets, door pads, door mechanisms, headliners, vinyl, and various other interior and exterior trim and finish pieces.
<b>Electrical Techs</b>	Install wiring, connect, and test various automotive electronic components.
<b>Upholstery Techs</b>	Measure, cut, and bond fabrics, leathers, foam, and carpet materials and wrap preformed frames.
<b>Press Brake Operator Sheet Metal Fabricator</b>	Use a variety of cutting, bending and other machines and hand tools to cut and form pieces to required dimensions.
<b>Drapery Seamstress</b>	Make custom window treatments and interior trims for vehicles
<b>Automotive Detailers</b>	Perform final vehicle detail and prep for customer delivery.
